Class of case defines the facilities input to care of the patient's initial disease; ANALYTIC = cases diagnosed and/or treated at Queen of the Valley Medical Center. NON-ANLYTIC = cases diagnosed and treated elsewhere but with active disease at Queen of the Valley Medical Center.

Age breakdown notes 86% of newly diagnosed cancer cases for 2016 were diagnosed at ages 50 and over. This is consistent with the age demographics of Napa county.

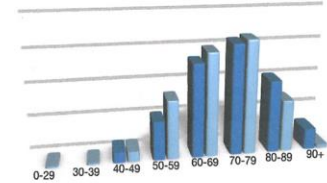

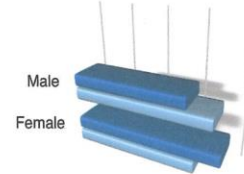

Sex distribution notes Queen of the Valley patients to be slightly reversed over the national comparison figures with there being more female NSCLC patients over male.

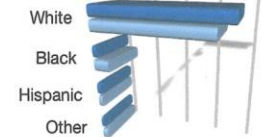

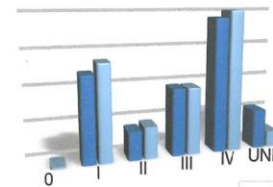

Race Distribution

Racial breakdown for Queen of the Valley note a 10% higher rate of white patients over that of the national data, however this is consistent with the local population demographics.

Stage distribution notes Queen of the Valley patients to be nearly the same as that of the national data with the exception of unknown stage, however this does coincide with patients seen for comorbidities in which cancer care is provided at outside facilities.
